Who are we looking for?

We are looking for people 16 years and over who:

- get support from social services and social care
- care for someone who gets support from social services and social care and
- relatives of service users who have an interest in CSSIW's work
- volunteers working in the social services/early years/care sectors
- voluntary organisations representing people, families and carers who use social services and social care

What will I need to do?

You will need to:

- share what you think about social services and the social care sector
- give ideas and say how you think social services and the social care sector can be better across Wales
- go to four National Advisory Board meetings in the year
- take part in a training session before the first National Advisory Board meeting
- be able to give four days of your time for work generated by attending the National Advisory Board. For example reading papers and preparing your thoughts and opinions before a meeting
- keep what other panel members say about themselves private
- agree to undertake a Disclosure and Barring Service check (previously Criminal and Records Bureau check) to check for suitability for working with children and vulnerable adults

There will be four meetings. We will pay for your expenses so that you can take part.
